Treatment goals of the patient exhibiting signs and symptoms of cardiac chest pain include: ensuring adequate oxygenation, relief of pain, rapid transport, and early notification of advanced life support.

- 1. Baseline care standards.
- 2. Administer oxygen 15L per minute via non-rebreather.
- 3. Minimize patient exertion and place in a position of comfort.
- 4. Obtain systolic / diastolic blood pressure readings in both arms and record.
- 5. If no specific contraindications, administer:
 - *Aspirin 162mg 325mg PO.*
- 6. If chest discomfort is present and systolic blood pressure is >100, administer:
 - *Nitroglycerine 0.4 mg SL* every 5 minutes up to three times.
- 7. Rapid transport and early notification to appropriate facility.
- 8. Request ALS intercept.
- 9. If chest discomfort persists, contact medical control for additional doses of nitroglycerine.
- 10. While en route, establish IV of Normal Saline and run TKO.
